Eligibility	
Professional Development	Provide evidence of consistent and significant contributions to the profession/practice of his or her career in clinical, administrative, teaching and/or research areas. (75 words)
Community Development	Provide evidence of leadership and achievement in community development by encouraging community partnership in health care or social integration of people with disability or dysfunction. (75 words)
Policy Development	Describe how he or she demonstrates providing clear scientific or tacit data to inform and support the health policy-making process. The focus of the contribution is influence on policy decisions that impact people's living and work circumstances and lifestyles. (75 words)
Volunteer Contributions	Describe his or her outstanding service in the community and/or professional development with excellent service marked by leadership and achievement. (75 words)
